Your group will bring to life a character in an image of the North or the South. One member of your group will play the part of your assigned character. A reporter will interview the characters.

Act-It-Out 1: The Transportation in the North and the South

Step 1: Make sure everyone in your group can answer these questions from the perspective of your assigned character:

- Where are you?
- What modes of transportation do you see around you?
- What are you doing in this location?
- Do you think the North or the South has better transportation? Why?

Step 2: Discuss how the person who is chosen to perform can make the character come alive through facial expressions, tone of voice, and posture. Then collect simple props to use during the act-it-out.

Act-It-Out 2: The Society of the North and the South

Step 1: Make sure everyone in your group can answer these questions from the perspective of your assigned character:

- Where do you live?
- Describe your way of life.
- What is the social structure like where you live?
- Would you rather live in the North or the South? Why?

Step 2: Discuss how the person who is chosen to perform can make the character come alive through facial expressions, tone of voice, and posture. Then collect simple props to use during the act-it-out.
